

Photo ID Required For Voting

(Effective July 1, 2014)

Voter Are You ID Ready?

- Valid Virginia Driver's License
 - DMV issued photo identification card
 - Valid United States Passport
 - Valid employee photo identification card
 - Other government issued photo identification card
 - Valid college or university student photo identification card (issuer must be an institution of higher education located in Virginia)
 - Valid Employee ID Card (must be issued in the ordinary course of business)
 - ID issued by a Government Agency of Virginia, or one of the Commonwealth's political subdivisions (counties, cities, towns, public high schools etc.), or The United States
 - Tribal enrollment or IDs issued by one of the 11 recognized tribes in Virginia**
 - The 11 tribes are: Cheroenhaka (Nottoway), Chickahominy, Eastern Chickahominy, Mattaponi, Monacan, Nansemond, Nottoway of Virginia, Pamunkey, Patawomneck, Rappahannock, and Upper Mattaponi
- ** Valid – the document is genuine, bears a photograph of the voter, and is not expired more than 12 months
