NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT AND PUBLIC HEARING**

**Ordinance 15-13**

**An Ordinance to  
Exempt by Designation the King William Historical Society and  
the Historical Society of West Point from  
King William County Real and Personal Property Taxes  
in Accordance with Section 58.1-3651 of the Code of Virginia**

The Board of Supervisors of King William County, Virginia, will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, December 14, 2015 at 7:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the Board Meeting Room of the County Administration Building, 180 Horse Landing Road, King William, Virginia, to receive public comment and to consider the ordinance captioned above.

Ordinance 15-13 will exempt the King William Historical Society and the Historical Society of West Point from County taxation on real and personal property owned now and in the future by the Societies so long as they operate as non-profit entities and the use of the property is for historical and/or cultural purposes. The exemptions will take effect on January 1, 2016. Current property owned by each society for which exemption is requested is as follows:

\*Neither entity owns any personal property assessed for taxation at this time
