**RE: PRESENTATION OF FY 2017 SCHOOL BUDGET AND BUDGET**

**WORK SESSION** – Stacy Johnson, Interim Division Superintendent, presented the proposed King William County Public School Budget for FY 2017 to the Board of Supervisors and a joint work session with the School Board was conducted thereon. The proposed school budget request is for level funding from the county. The proposal includes additional positions and salary raises for employees due to an expected increase of \$630,000 in state funds. Also, the schools are expected to pay a smaller debt service in the upcoming fiscal year. A brief question and answer period followed the budget presentation.

Topics of discussion included a recent article that provided a scenario of services and programs that could be cut should the minimum state requirement be allocated by the county; whether additional state funding would allow for a reduction in

local funding; increases in healthcare costs; the possibility of lottery funds becoming available to localities if passed by the General Assembly; and VRS contributions.
